READY TO ROCK? TRACK TREMORS WITH UT WEBSITE Texas residents can now track seismic activity in real time from the comfort of their armchairs. An interactive website has been set up that puts TexNet, the state's earthquake monitoring network set up by The University of Texas at Austin Bureau of Economic Geology, just a few clicks away. TexNet, which has 22 permanent and 40 portable monitoring stations statewide, was authorized by Gov. Greg Abbott and the Legislature in June 2015 with \$4.5 million in funding. Like many other areas in the south-central U.S., Texas has experienced an increase in the number of earthquakes during the past decade, especially in the Dallas-Fort Worth area, the Permian Basin region and south-central Texas.
