The Non-Vertebrate Paleontology Laboratory, as part of the Jackson School of Geosciences Museum of Earth History at the University of Texas at Austin, houses over 4 million specimens of minerals, meteorites, rocks and fossils. Most collections are located at the J. J. Pickle Research Campus. Many mineral specimens are on display at the Texas Memorial Museum, the **Bureau of Economic Geology** and other geosciences buildings on campus, including 140 particularly fine specimens collected from all over the world by the late Col. Elbert McBee Barron (1903-1969), a former Texas legislator who also served under General Douglas MacArthur in Australia during WWII.
