AGENDA ITEM 1

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Vaughn at 9:05 am CST.

AGENDA ITEM 2

Meeting minutes from September 20, 2017 were presented for approval. Motion was made to approve minutes as written. Motion was seconded and minutes were unanimously adopted.

Dr. Peter Hennings and Dr. Ellen Rathje presented for approval to include the Seismic Hazard and Risk project portfolio in the TexNet FY 2017-19 budget. Request was acknowledged. Motion was made to approve the addition of Seismic Hazard and Risk to the FY 2017-19 budget. Motion was seconded and Seismic Hazard and Risk was unanimously adopted into the FY 2017-19 budget, however, the detailed, itemized budget numbers are to be distributed to the TAC with final approval scheduled during the next meeting.
